PROGRAM NOTES

The rich legacy that Carmen Dragon (1914–1984) left the musical world usually includes mention of his conducting work with the Glendale Symphony Orchestra, the Hollywood Bowl Orchestra, and the Capitol Symphony, in addition to his solid reputation as a consummate orchestrator. Most people are surprised to also learn that he won an Oscar in 1944, an Entry in 1964, wrote the music for almost 40 feature films, and has his own star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame.

He is, however, best remembered for the iconic arrangement of *America*, the *Beautiful*, which he scored in 1958, in dual scorings for symphony orchestra and symphonic band [grade 4 original setting, Alfred item number FXB123]. Samuel Ward's familiar tune enjoys a sumptuous feast of harmonic color and instrumental nuance, and for the very first time, this American masterpiece is now available in an edition for younger players and their audiences to enjoy. All of the majestic beauty and avesome grandeur of Dragon's original is preserved in this new scoring, with appropriate accommodations made for less experienced instrumentalists.
