NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

Gustav Holst's two suites for military band have long been considered not only great musical works but also the foundation for literature written directly for the wind band. The movements of the Second Suite in F are based entirely on folk songs and Morris dances. In the finale, "Fantasia on the 'Dargason," "Holst combines the "Dargason" and "Greensleeves" in a wonderful simultaneous counterpoint.

When the "Greensleeves" melody appears in measure 49, and again in measure 113, it is recommended that the music be conducted in "one" since some instruments are in 6/8 and others are in 3/4. The bass and flute parts beginning in measure 161 may be performed by one player each or by the whole section

Great care was taken to make this arrangement playable for young musicians while at the same time maintaining the spirit and integrity of Holst's original work. I hope you and your students find this to be a rewarding and worthwhile experience. Best wishes for a wonderful performance!
