PROGRAM NOTES

The planet Mars has been in the news lately, not only with the apparent recent discovery of water on the surface, but also with plans to inhabit the "red planet." At least two programs are currently underway to send mankind to Mars. The *Mars One* project has proposed plans to send humans to the surface of Mars in 2025, and the *Inspiration Mars Foundation* is planning on rocketing two people close to Mars as early as 2018.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Project Mars is a mostly original work for beginning band that also borrows a few phrases from Gustav Holst's "Mars" from *The Planets*.

The opening and closing fanfares should be played solidly but without overblowing.

There is a part written for brake drum. If that instrument is not available, you may substitute an anvil or any other loud metallic object.

You may need to adjust the dynamic level in measures 40–43 so the melody in the low winds is prominent.
