

Jeopardy Theme



Tubes required:

(Tubes are listed in order of occurrence in the music for each part. For the "Low" tubes, use bass tubes or tubes with Octave™ caps.)

Melody: C F Low F A G D Low Bb Low A Low G

Accompaniment: Low F Low C Low D Low E


Optional: Very Low F (two octaves below F); use a bass tube with an Octave™ cap)

Teaching suggestions:

- Give each student one or two tubes as shown below. Seat all but four students in a semicircle: Low F / C & F / A & G / F & D / D & C / Low Bb & Low A / Low F / Low G / Low A.
- Seat the four remaining students in front and middle to play the accompaniment: Low F / Low C & Low D / Low B & Low F / Very Low F (opt.)



- Teach parts by note.
- The melody also works well on Off! bowed instruments.



Batman Theme

(From the TV Series)



Tables required:

(Tables are listed in order of occurrence in the music for each part. For the "Low" tables, use bass tables or tables with Octave™ cups.)

Pattern A (top and bottom staff): Low G (throughout pattern) D C_b C_a

(Seat three students together to play D, C_b, and C_a; if you have enough tables, give each student two each of the same pitch. Seat one student facing them to play two Low G tables.)

Melody 1: E, G

(Assign two students to play Melody 1 with each holding one F and one G table.)

Pattern B (top and bottom staff): Low C (throughout pattern) Low G Low F_b Low F_a

(Seat three students together to play Low G, Low F_b, and Low F_a; seat one student facing them to play two Low C tables.)

Melody 2: B_b, High C

(Assign two students to play Melody 2 with each holding one B_b and one High C table.)

Pattern C (top and bottom staff): Low D (throughout pattern) A A_b G

(Seat three students together to play A, A_b, and G; seat one student facing them to play two Low D tables.)

Melody 3: C, D

Optional Ending: (all three staffs): D, Low G (from Pattern A)

Low D, Low G, E, G, B_b (final two chords; anyone with these tables should play!)

Teaching suggestions:

- See seating and table assignment suggestions above. There are three basic harmonies (patterns), all with straight eighth-note rhythms. Learn these one at a time, adding the melody line that goes with it before moving on to the next pattern.
- Copy and enlarge the visual to help put the sections together for performance. The letters represent the patterns, and the numbers represent the melodic parts. The form is only a suggestion—adapt it to your needs.
- Younger children will enjoy moving to the "Be" music. If possible, have a Recrewhackoff ensemble play "Batman Theme."
