### PROGRAM NOTES

An opening statement portrays a bold, introspective and aggressive burst of fanfare-like energy, written to showcase the intensity of revolt. The piece abruptly transitions to an ominous and still aggressively spirited section, offering a chance for every section of the band to shine. The middle section shimmers depicting a much needed and calmer emotional release before the revolt against authority returns with its relentless energy.


### REHEARSAL SUGGESTIONS

For full effect, it is important to take note of the suddenly intense tempo change at m. 8. Also at m. 8 to m. 25, the dynamic marking indicates “mf” but this should be a “macho” section. At m. 44, for dramatic effect, every section should be well balanced. The percussion section is essential throughout, and balance is also important to take note of between percussion and winds. However, throughout the entire work, woodblock is essential and should stand out at appropriate times. The rolls on woodblock and tambourine are important. At m. 81, the main “revolt” theme comes back and should be played equally, if not more aggressively as the first time. M. 93 to the end are meant to be increasingly loud and clashing.

I hope you enjoy preparing and performing **Insurrection**.

He is also the lead pianist and residential composer for his church, where he has arranged and composed many works for small choirs and chamber orchestras. He maintains a tight and busy schedule of composing and arranging, performing, and traveling. Additionally, Jay has composed numerous works for wind band for just about every level. Jay's music is published by Carl Fischer Music and Birch Island Co, as well as works that are self-published which can be found on his website. Jay accredits composers and mentors Brian Balmages, Larry Clark, Ryan Main, and Michael Markowski for their guidance and many lessons that continue to shape his music—all those lessons that motivate him to thrive as a composer.
