

Program Notes

Growing up in Edison, New Jersey, during the winters at the first sign of snow, my brother and I would anxiously await word that school had been called off. We knew that if school closed on account of dangerous roads, half the town would still find a way to Bishop Ahr High School for the best sledding in the area.

The Red Sled is a nostalgic depiction of such a day. As the piece opens, we wake to find snow on the ground and soon are walking in the crisp, cold air. We then drive to the school, climb the hill, and clumsily fall down the slope. As you listen to the music, see if you can tell when we climb up and then tumble down on **The Red Sled**.

Rehearsal Suggestions

Notes are to be played light and separated, with the exception of m. 26-37.

M. 32-37 cues –horn should accompany alto saxophones if range permits.

M. 50-73 – dramatic dynamic contrasts.

M. 56-59, m. 66-69 – percussion is arranged in 2 competing groups. Balance the percussion accordingly making sure each grouping is fully covered (triangle, temple blocks, and sleigh bells *versus* snare drum, bass drum, and cymbal.)

M. 59, m. 69 – the last note of these measures is supposed to be played as loudly as the students can play musically.

M. 69-70 – the bass drum ends m. 69 with a quarter note played as loudly as possible followed by a quarter note in the following measure, which is to be played as softly as possible.

M. 59 – try to keep the sleigh bells from sustaining into the next beat.

I hope your ensemble and audiences enjoy **The Red Sled**.
