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## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

On June 25th, 1956, the jazz world lost a true icon and innovator of bebop, trumpeter Clifford Brown. He was only 25 when he passed but was able to leave us with a wonderful legacy of recordings.

Composer and tenor saxophonist Benny Golson composed *I Remember Clifford* as a tribute to Clifford Brown in 1957. The two had once performed together in vibraphonist Lionel Hampton's band. As the arranger, I tried to maintain the sentiment of Golson's original melody without too much variation.

Accordingly, the second trumpet (flugelhorn) is featured prominently as a soloist. Eighth notes are to be performed generally straight and much attention should be given to dynamic contrasts as written.

Dynamics are essential to this chart. Every player should strive to be sensitive to balance and blend at all times. Releases should be uniform for all wind sections. Keep in mind that a clean release will make every band sound more mature and polished.

One of the challenges of a slow ballad is maintaining accurate time, forward motion, and a certain amount of energy as well. Regarding intonation, the transparency of a ballad exposes potential pitch issues so each wind player should strive to listen intently and blend.

The double time section at m. 40 can be set up by the drummer subtly providing the double time feel, and the drummer can similarly set up the return to the original ballad tempo.
