### **NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR**

I encourage you to play a recording of the original to your students to help them understand and internalize the rhythmic aspects of swing.

The percussion 1 part is written for two players—one on snare and suspended cymbal and one on bass drum. It also could be performed by one player on drumset. Unless otherwise marked, all quarter notes should be played for their full value.
