PROGRAM NOTES

Exuberance! was composed after experiencing a feeling of complete and total elation. All of us have experienced that buoyant, lighter-than-air feeling from time to time when something wonderful and unexpected happens. Trying to take that sense of infectious hopefulness and capture it in sound is the essence of this piece. Exuberance! is a great way to start any concert!

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

The percussion intro starts as if far away, and then leads to a dramatic trumpet statement as if a feeling of exhilaration was bubbling up to the surface. Keep the woodwind harmonies at measure 18 nice and full, taking care to bring out the low and inner voices for an excellent and lush sound. The bass drum and crash cymbal parts are written in tandem, ensuring they are both played at the same volume. The woodwind lines throughout provide the sparkle to the music. Again, take care to balance the upper voices with the lower voices.
