One of England's most popular carols, the Sussex Carol is often referred to by its first line, "On Christmas night all Christians sing." The lyrics date to the 17th century, and its melody dates from 1919 when British composer Ralph Vaughan Williams and folk-song collector Cecil Sharp heard it being sung in Sussex, hence the name "Sussex Carol." Usually performed in a spirited $\mathbf{6}$, this version sets the tune in a slower $\mathbf{3}_{4}$ time, allowing younger musicians to enjoy playing this delightful tune.
